STANDING Together is an international collaborative effort to build standards for health data, to encourage more transparency and reduce the impacts of biased algorithms. So far >200 experts from 24 countries has taken part, including experts from medical device regulators including the FDA, MHRA (UK) and TGA (Australia). We are hoping to interview experts overseeing data curation efforts or using health data to drive algorithm development in different countries to understand their experiences and the applicability of the standards across different countries.
